

Green River Gun Club Range Rules & Usage Agreement

RANGE RULES

1. Always keep the gun pointed in a safe direction.
2. Always keep your finger off the trigger until ready to shoot.
3. Always keep your gun unloaded until ready to shoot and always treat EVERY gun as though it were loaded.
4. Know your target and beyond. Make sure the downrange area is unoccupied.
5. Be sure the gun is safe to operate.
6. Know the gun and its safety features.
7. Use only the correct ammunition for your gun.
8. Ear and eye protection must be worn at all times while on the firing line.
9. Alcohol and drugs are not permitted on range property.
10. Unattended guns should never be left accessible to unauthorized persons.
11. The Cowboy Action range is to be used for competition only.
12. The Gale Stiles Range is restricted to handguns and rimfire only.
13. Use only target stands and targets approved by and/or provided by the club. (Glass bottles and cans are not to be used as targets)
14. Metal rails, target stands and other range structures are never to be fired at or used as targets.
15. Sign in and out each time you use the range. The only exception to this is when attending a scheduled event.
16. Close and lock the gate when arriving or departing the range. The only exception to this is when attending a scheduled event.
17. During scheduled practice times and shooting events the Range Officer(s) have total control of the range facilities.
18. During non-scheduled practices, when Range Officers are not present, safety rules must be strictly followed. Please help others observe these rules.
19. NEVER duplicate or loan your key (or combination code, if provided) to ANYONE.
20. No one other than club members and their guests may use the range facilities. Guests must be accompanied by a Green River Gun Club member and that member will be held responsible for their guests' actions.
21. Hunting is not permitted on range property.
22. NEVER go downrange without receiving positive acknowledgement from everyone present that you are going down range.
23. When on the firing line, if anyone goes down range, make your gun safe by UNLOADING IT, placing it on the bench, and LEAVING IT UNTOUCHED until they return to the firing line.

By signing, I acknowledge receiving the above information, understand the rules set forth and will follow them. I understand when I use Green River Gun Club facilities I do so at my own risk and agree to hold the Green River Gun Club, Club Officers, and Club members free and harmless of any liability incurred on said property.
